

Camp Donegal Discipline Policy & Transportation Release

Throughout your child's stay at Camp Donegal, our staff works hard to promote the spiritual, emotional and physical growth and safety of your child. All campers are asked to sign a camper agreement before coming to camp which promises their understanding of camp life and rules. When a camper's behavior becomes a danger to others or to themselves, staff will intervene and hopefully resolve the conflict in a healthy, positive way. Counselors are trained in speaking with campers about what is bothering them and what might have prompted a behavior. If a camper is non-compliant with the safe environment we create, the camper will be sent home without refund of camp fees.

It is our hope that we can intercede and work to resolve conflict in healthy ways before this drastic step must be taken.

Behavioral Expectations

- We expect campers to respect each other, the counselors and staff, the property and most of all themselves.
- We expect campers to follow directions, be polite, and to obey the rules.
- Shoes (not sandals or Crocs) must be worn at all times, except at the pool.
