## Health Form

Each camper who comes to camp must bring a completed health form so that the camp nurse has an accurate record of their health needs. This health form is available on our web site. If there is any information that we should know before your arrival at camp in order to best serve your needs, please mail the form in ahead of time. Thank you!

## Camp Pictures and DVDs

You will have the opportunity at registration to order a camp picture and/or DVD. The camp picture is an 8X10 color group photograph of all campers and staff involved in your camp program. The camp DVD is a compilation of many candid photos taken during your camp week. The camp pictures and DVDs cost \$6.00 each, and will be mailed to your home approximately 4 weeks after the close of your week at camp.

## Camp Store Vouchers

Each day, campers have an opportunity to visit the camp store for about a half an hour in the afternoon. The camp store offers snacks, drinks, T-shirts, hats, flashlights, stationery and necessities. For safety reasons, we ask that campers not have money at camp. Therefore, the camp store operates on a voucher system. During registration, you may purchase a camp store voucher to use for the week. Any change will be available for pickup at the end of the week.

## Camper Mail

Mail is so important! Please be sure to pack stationery and stamps for letters home. Also, be sure to write letters to your camper at camp—even encourage family and friends to do so! Letters may also be written ahead of time to insure that they are here when the campers arrive—simply write the day that you wish for the letter to be delivered on the lower left corner of the envelope.
