Our Philosophy

At Camp Donegal, our goal is to lovingly accept each child, meet them where they are in their faith journey, and provide them a fun and safe place to explore and question faith issues. Some key parts to who we are include:

Small Group Camping: In addition to their Cabin Groups, campers are divided into Family Groups of 8 to 12 campers. This allows for more meaningful relationships to form as the members of each family group become more familiar with each other over the course of the week.

Challenge by Choice: We believe that campers should not be forced to participate in activities they find scary or that make them uncomfortable. Our staff will encourage those who seem reluctant, but ultimately the decision to participate rests with the camper.

Our Curriculum: Each summer Camp Donegal develops a Biblically based curriculum to help campers grow in their faith through daily Bible studies and the use of Scripture, discussion, songs, activities and games to help campers grow closer to God.

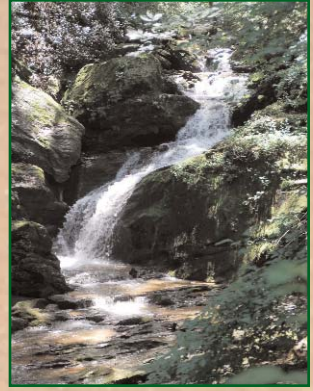

ANSWERS TO COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can I come with a friend? Yes. We will place you in a cabin with one other camper if the request is made on both campers' registration forms. Please do not include more than one camper's name.

Is financial aid available? Yes. Most local churches have campership funds available. Check with your pastor or Session. Should additional financial assistance be needed, please contact the camp office for a scholarship application.

May I register in an event for an age level other than my own? Only if absolutely necessary. Program content is designed to be appropriate for a specific narrow age group. An attempt is made to stay faithful to the age level so that campers don't have an unhappy time dealing with activities that are not designed for their developmental level.

How do I know what to bring to camp? A complete list is sent to each camper approximately 4 weeks prior to your camp week. This list is also available on our web site.

How much spending money will I need at camp? None. Camp Store vouchers for the purchase of snacks, t-shirts, hats, bug spray, etc. are available at registration. For the camper's protection, the camp prefers that campers have no cash on hand.

Can my child bring food or snacks to camp? No. More than enough food and snacks are provided (three meals a day and an evening snack). Campers also can purchase candy and snacks when their group goes to the camp store most days. The camp administrator will hold any food brought or sent to camp until the end of the week.

Will my brother or sister and I be in the same cabin? No. You must specifically

request to be housed with a sibling.

Is there medical staff at camp? Yes. We have a camp nurse on site 24 hours a day.

How is camper medication handled at camp? At the time of registration, all medicine and pertinent information is taken from the campers by the camp nurse. The medicine is stored in a safe place and administered by the camp nurse as directed.

Can campers bring cell phones to camp?

No. We do not allow campers to have cell phones. If a problem arises, a camp representative will be in touch with parents, and if deemed necessary, or if requested by the parents, we will put you in touch with your child. We will never prevent a parent from speaking to their child.

How can I stay in contact with my child?

We encourage you to write letters or send emails through the ecamp program available on our web site.

What happens if a camper becomes

homesick? An extra dose of love is given to help the camper feel more at home at camp. In some cases, parents are phoned by the camp administrator to discuss the matter. In severe cases, the child may return home.

HOW TO REGISTER FOR CAMP

All registrations require a \$100 non-refundable deposit. Fee balances must be postmarked by May 12th for early bird bonus.

Scholarships:

Many local churches provide financial help to youth from their congregations who wish to attend camp. If you need financial aid, contact your church. If additional assistance is needed, contact the camp office. Camp Donegal has a limited scholarship fund to assist youth unable to secure financial help from their churches.

Early Bird Bonus:

Campers who pay their entire camp fee by May 12, 2012 will receive one \$10 Camp Store voucher per person per camp. PAYMENT MUST BE IN FULL AND POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN MAY 12, 2012.

Multiple Camp Discount:

For campers registering for more than one camp, a \$35 discount will be applied. This discount applies only to individual campers, not siblings.

First Time Family Discount:

To encourage new families to experience our Family Camp ministry, Camp Donegal is offering a special "First Time Family Discount" to new camping families enrolling for a Family Camp Weekend. Your family is eligible for a \$5 per person (up to \$40 per family) discount.

Grade Levels:

Grade levels listed in this brochure indicate grade completed by the end of the 2011/2012 school year.

Refunds:

Camp fees are refundable, less a \$100 processing fee, or fully transferable towards another camp up to 48 hours prior to the start of your camp. Please contact the camp office as soon as possible if you need to make a change to your registration.
